Daily PDB Updates (Producer Central only): PDB Updates Summary - Producers with Completed Updates	<p>A new PDB Updates Summary Box is now displayed on the Producer Central home page. This box summarizes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of distinct producers with pending updates

Feature	Description
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of distinct producer records that were synced with PDB in the last day, 7 days, and 30 days.• Each agency record that shares an EIN, such as branch offices, will count separately in the total. Not every producer record will reflect a data change as a result of processing these updates.
Enhancement to Close Outdated Producer Express Requests	<p>Over the years, not all producer requests were fully processed or explicitly closed. These orphaned requests would occasionally show up in large numbers to slow load times in the workspace or add extra processing time for the application. Starting with our 5/22/2020 production release, Vertafore will begin to close out any of these expired requests that are still incomplete after one year.</p> <p>Key points to this change:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Starting with the oldest, expired producer requests, Producer Express will close, up to 1,000 packets per customer per day, to reduce impact to downstream systems.• A milestone will be added at the same time Producer Express updates the request to Closed.• The Licensing Specialist workspace criteria will have a check box for Expired Requests Only that can be used in conjunction with other criteria options to search for packets closed with this new milestone. <p>Please reach out to your customer account team for any questions.</p>
